TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNS

Bids need to be placed in a sealed envelope plainly marked "*Traffic Control Sign Bid*". Bids will be opened at the regularly scheduled Finance Committee meeting on Wednesday, March 3, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. Awarded bids will be approved at the regularly scheduled board meeting on Wednesday, March 10, 2021.

Material must meet the 2012 MDOT Standard Specifications and be on MDOT Qualified Products list.

Blanks shall be aluminum unless approved in writing by the Road Commission.

The Road Commission anticipates purchasing approximately 100 signs of various types and sizes throughout the ensuing 12 months.

The Road Commission's bid form must be used. The Kalkaska County Road Commission reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids, to waive irregularities or defects in a bid, or to accept that bid which, in the opinion of the Road Commission, is in the best interest of the county.

This bid is for supplying the above-described materials and/or services to the Kalkaska County Road Commission from the date of acceptance through March 3, 2021. The Road Commission reserves the right to extend these unit prices for an additional period of time of up to 12 months beyond that date by mutual consent of both parties.
